### JUNCTION BLOCK

**All Models (1965-72)** — Located in engine compartment in left front of vehicle.

### FUSE PANEL

**"J" Models & Wagoneer (1973-74)** — Located under dash panel to right of steering column.

**Cherokee (1974)** — Located under dash panel to right of steering column.

### CIRCUIT BREAKERS

**All Models (1965-71)** — Lighting circuit is protected by circuit breaker located on rear of light switch. On Jeepster models, another breaker is incorporated in the wire loom to give additional protection to directional and hazard flashers, cigar lighter, and horn.

**All Models (1972-74)** — Circuit breakers protect lighting circuit, windshield wiper/washer motor circuit, and for "J" models where applicable, electric rear window circuit.

### IN-LINE FUSES

**Jeepster (1967-71)** — In-line fuses protect circuits for clock, windshield wiper motor and heater.

**Commando (1972-73) & Cherokee (1974)** — In-line fuses protect circuits for heater fan switch, back-up light switch (manual transmission), windshield wiper motor, and 4-way hazard flasher switch.

**"CJ" & "DJ" Models (1965-71)** — In-line fuses protect circuits to directional flashers and 4-way emergency hazard flasher (when equipped).

**"CJ" & "DJ" Models (1972-74)** — In-line fuses protect circuits to directional signals, 4-way emergency hazard flasher, cigar lighter, and fan switch.

**"J" Series, All Models including Wagoneer (1965-72)** — In-line fuses protect circuits for heater, directional flashers, windshield wiper motor, and relay circuit.
