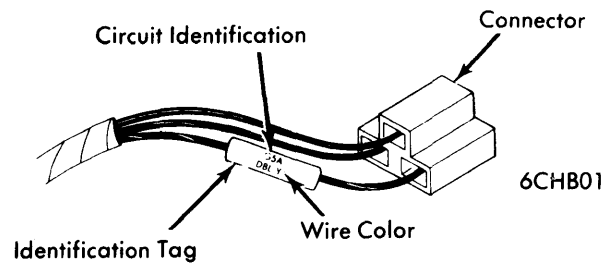


CHRYSLER CORP. WIRING COLOR CHANGES

Due to temporary material shortages, Chrysler Corporation may substitute wire colors other than those shown on wiring diagrams. To aid in diagnosis, when substitute wire colors are used an identification tag will be located about 2" back from the connector (see illustration). This tag will show circuit identification and color the wire should be. Disregard the actual color of the wire and always refer to the I. D. tag when color of wires are not the same as shown in wiring diagrams. For example, in the sample shown (see illustration), the correct wire color would be Dark Blue with a Yellow tracer even though the actual wire used could be Green, Black, or any other color.
