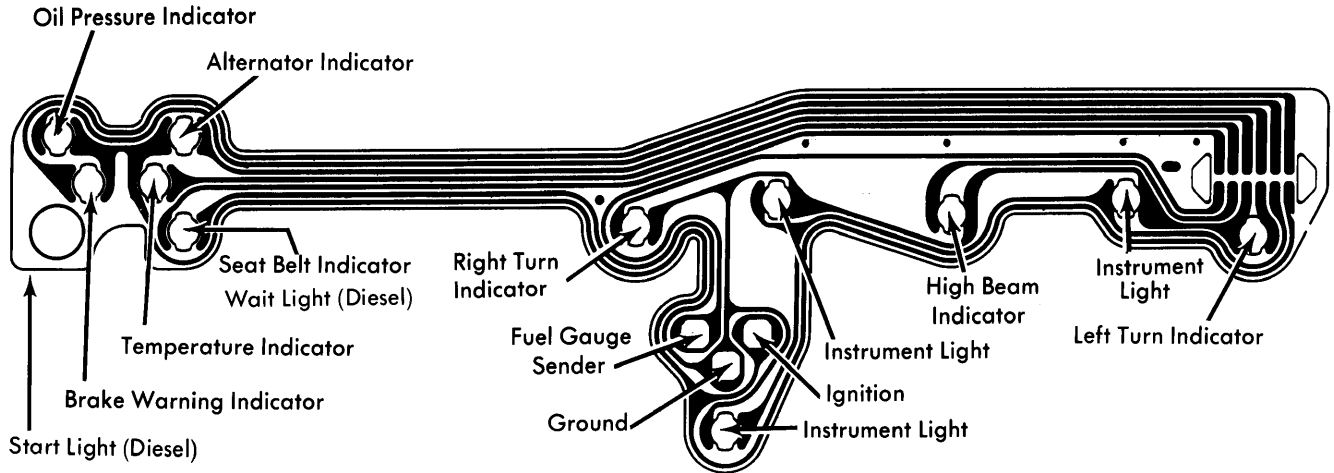
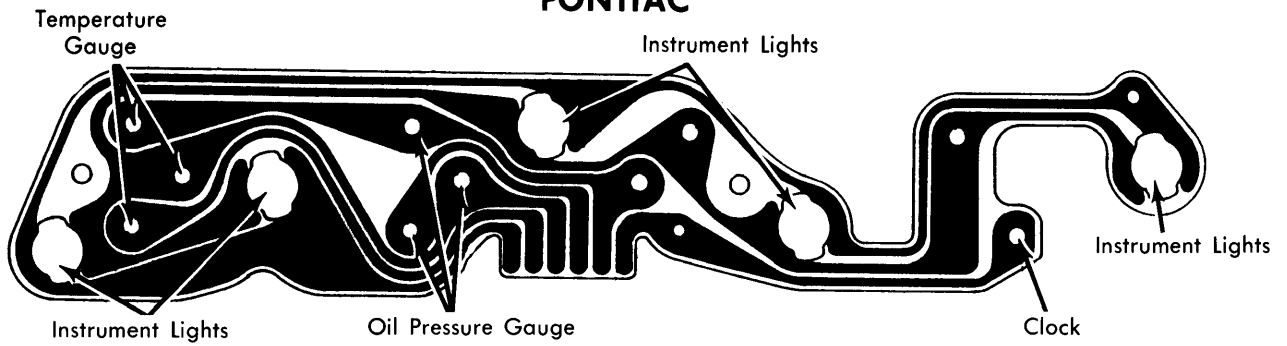

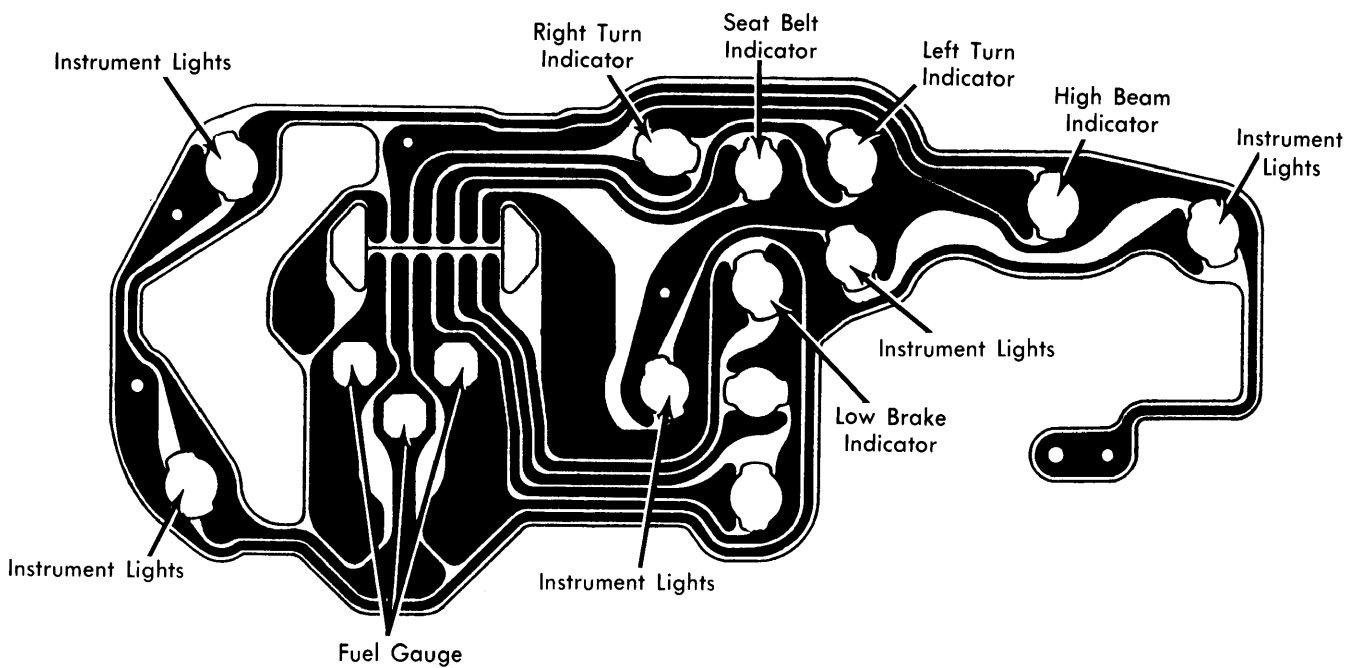


Delta 88 and Ninety Eight Instrument Cluster

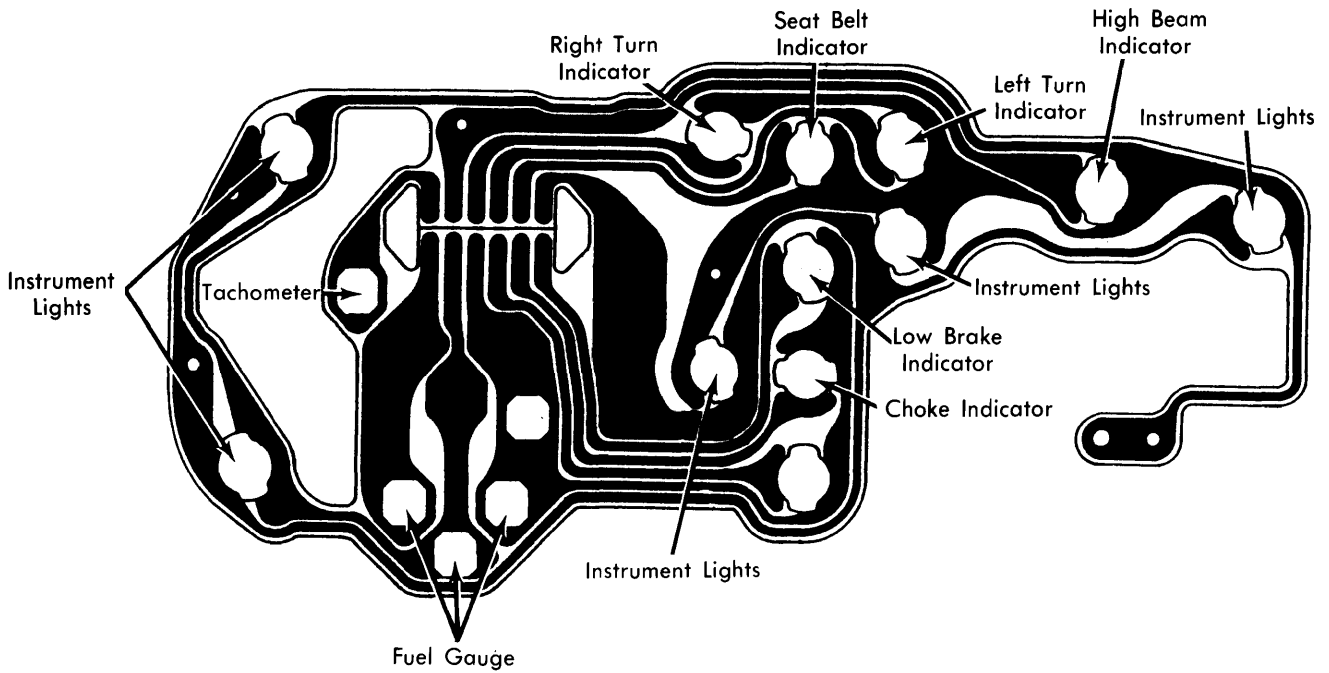


Phoenix Instrument Cluster with Indicator Lights

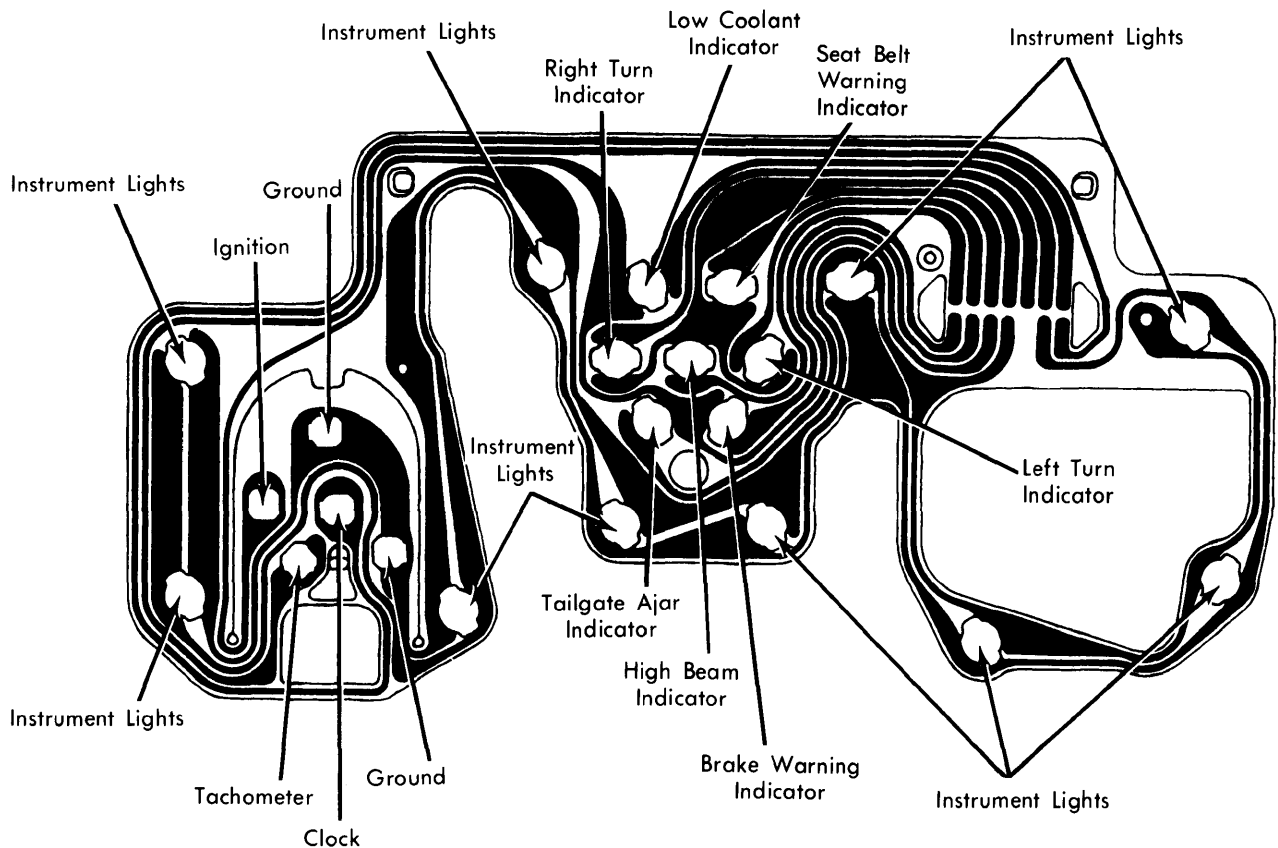


Phoenix Instrument Cluster without Tachometer

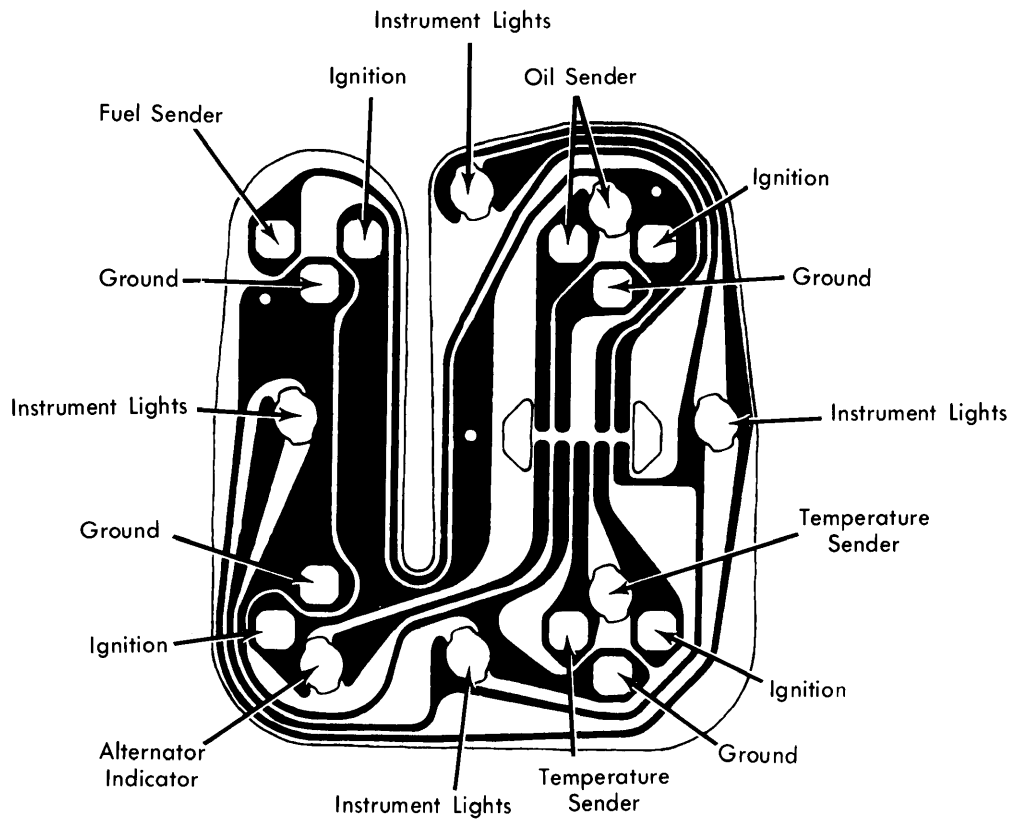


Phoenix Instrument Cluster with Tachometer

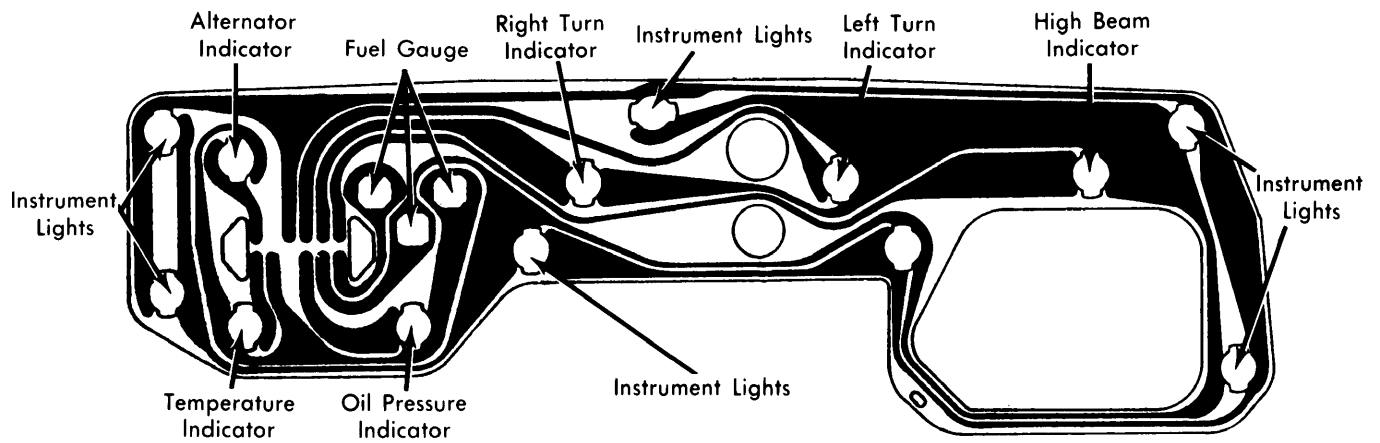


LeMans & Grand Prix Instrument Cluster

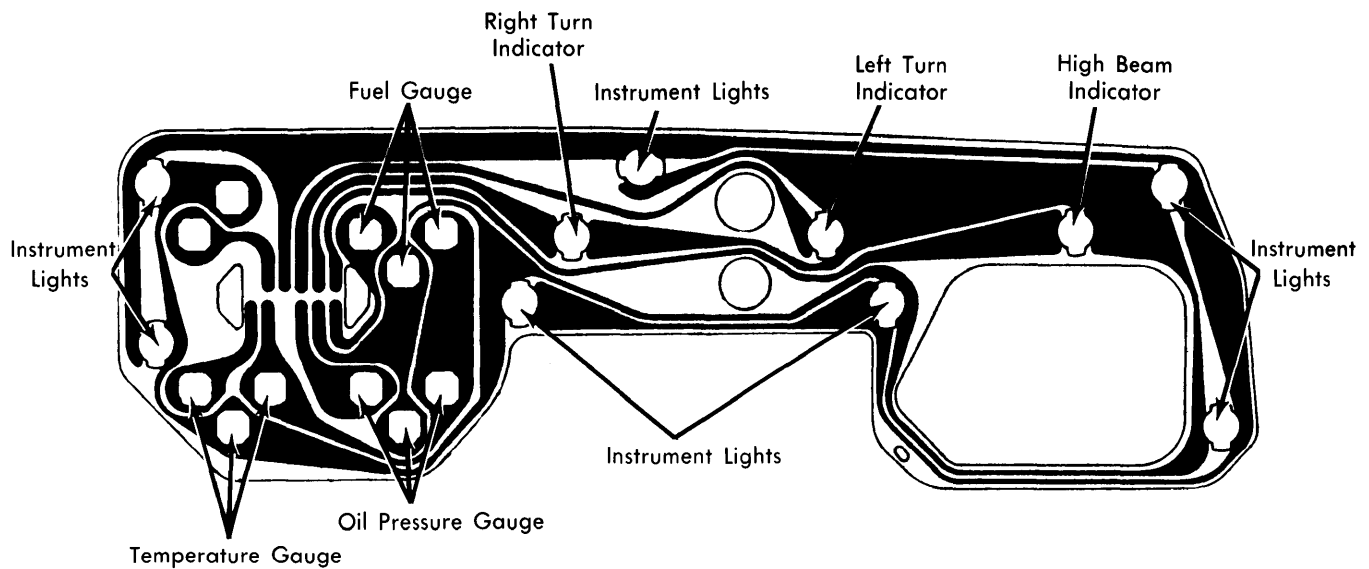


LeMans & Grand Prix Auxiliary Instrument Cluster

Special Wiring Notes

GENERAL MOTORS BODY CODES

NOTE — On General Motors cars, body wiring differs in accordance with body type ("A", "B", etc.). Refer to table to identify wiring diagrams for any particular model. Body code letter is the second letter of body number plate. The body number plate is located on firewall of engine compartment.
